FREE MEDICARE COUNSELING



In order to assure people have the most complete and cost-effective Medicare coverage, Ridgefield Social Services is once again offering free Medicare counseling sessions from October 15 through December 7, during Medicare's Open Enrollment period. Medicare Advantage and Prescription drug plans often make changes each year to costs, coverages, and network providers. It is only during Open Enrollment, covered individuals can change their coverage for the upcoming year to best meet their needs for the coming year. One-on-one sessions provide free confidential counseling, explanation of benefits and assistance to people with Medicare. Last year, Karen Gaudian, of Ridgefield Social Services, and Ridgefield's trained Medicare counselors met with over 100 local residents and were able to save them a total of \$46,500 in prescription costs.

Call to set up an appointment today! Covered individuals and counselors will use Medicare's website to find the most economical coverage, taking into account prescriptions, deductibles, co-payments, and expected medical care needs for 2018.

Social Services will also be hosting a number of informational programs.
