## CONVOCATION OF PRIESTS 2017

Bishop Caggiano is asking for prayers as he and all the priests throughout the Diocese of Bridgeport prepare to gather at the Fifth Convocation of Priests of the Diocese of Bridgeport, from Sunday, October 15, through Wednesday, October 18. The Convocation, which is held every three years, will be held in Newport, Rhode Island.

The theme of the Convocation is "Of One Heart and Mind: Brothers United in Christ." The purpose of the gathering is to strengthen the fraternal bonds among our priests and provide a time of spiritual renewal so that they may return with an even greater commitment to service.

Masses will not be celebrated in parishes throughout the diocese from Monday, October 15<sup>th</sup> through Wednesday, October 18<sup>th</sup>. However, members of the Jesuit Community at Fairfield University and other religious order priests will be available for sacramental emergencies.

Thank you for your prayers and support for this very important event in the lives of our priests and our Diocese.

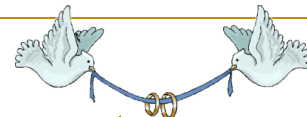
